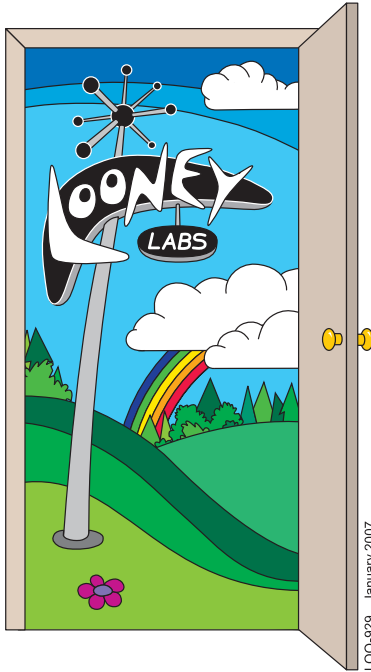

Do you teach about extinction, pollution, food chains, or environmental issues?



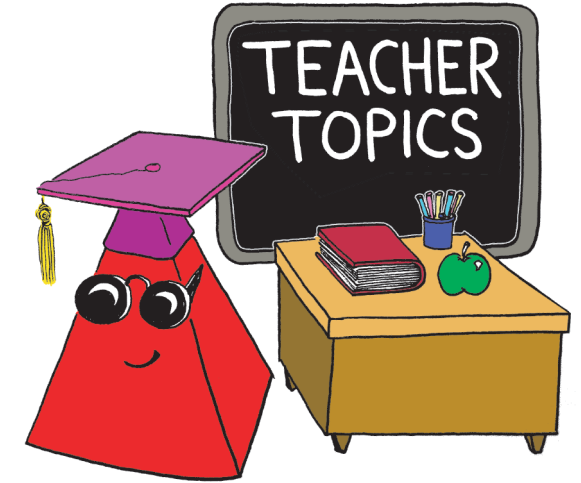
EcoFluxx has all the skill-building of **Fluxx** and **Family Fluxx**, with a science content
